It's, hard to believe that it is already March and some of our snow birds will be leaving the nest to head north. We will miss you and look forward to seeing you next fall.

You are responsible for your property and you should hire someone to come in once a month to pull weeds and take care of any outside issues.

I would suggest shutting off your water at the meter. Do not lock the meter as it belongs to US Water. If you have an empty RV pad, I would suggest shutting off the electric and locking the box. The meter belongs to Duke Energy and the box and stand are yours. If you have any questions about water or electric bills during the summer, please call me and I will check on your concerns. If you can, shut off your hot water heater.

If you are a new property owner with a park model, you can give me a set of keys which are locked in a lock box in case of an emergency or give an extra set of keys to another property owner who is here year-round.

<u>Please note</u>: I have received a call from the county that someone has been throwing brush, etc. over onto county property from their yard. There is a fine for this from the county and if caught, you will be fined. There is pickup every day, Monday thru Friday; place your clippings, branches, etc. at the end of your drive and it will be picked up by our maintenance crew.

It has been a pleasure meeting all of the new property owners. Drive home safe and I'll see you next year. Remember that I am here all year long and will assist you with any issues that arise while you are north.
