

Camp Florida POA Election Committee Rules and Regulations

- The Election Committee chairperson is responsible for maintaining the CF Quorum Attendance Requirement and Voting Registration and ensuring that the log is up to date will all current Property Owners in good standing.
- The Camp Florida POA Elections are held on the Third Saturday in February which is the same day as our Annual meeting. This is referred to as the Property Owners meeting.
- Candidates interested in seeking a position on the board must be a property owner and be in good standing.
- Each candidate must submit a Letter of Intent with a one-page resume to the Election Committee Chairperson. This document must be submitted by the end of January or as designated by the Election Committee.
- Board member terms are for two years.
- You are only voting for members to the board.
- The POA officers are determined by the newly elected board members after the election.
- Nominations are also accepted from the floor the day of the election.
- In the event that a property owner is unable to be present on election day a proxy vote may be used to submit a vote.
- Proxy votes must be submitted by Camp Florida property owners only.
