"CRITTER" of the Month

Culicoides aka NO-SEE-UMS/biting midges part of the Ceratopogonidae family. 47 species are known to occur in Florida. The picture below depicts an adult biting midge, showing a blood-filled abdomen. Biting midges are holometabolous (complete metamorphosis), progressing from egg to larva to pupa, and finally to the adult stage. The complete cycle can occur in two to six weeks. In the US, the biting midges are primarily a nuisance, and the major medical issue associated with Culicoides is allergic reactions to the bites. Historically, management methods included diking and drainage of marshlands to reduce the habitats used by the immature stages.

Coastal areas provide primary habitat for biting midges. Tourists and potential home and land owners consult local maps prior to visiting or purchasing coastal areas to determine the proximity to producing areas.
